



OBTAINING TEST AUTHORIZATION CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY

To obtain a Certificate of Eligibility through the Joint Services Aviation Maintenance Technician Certification Council (JSAMTCC):

1. Contact your service representative, who will verify you are eligible for the Joint Services Airframe & Powerplant Certification Program.

2. Once given access, complete the three online courses: 02AF1-General, 02AF2-Airframe, and 02AF3-Powerplant. Each course includes a quiz which must be passed with a minimum score of 70%.
3. After completing the online courses, your service representative will provide the process for verifying and/or completing the required 30 months of experience.
4. Once your experience has been verified, your service representative will issue a CG-G-EAE-4 Form, Certificate of Eligibility (COE). The COE will be your test authorization; if you hold a COE, you do NOT need to obtain an FAA Form 8610-2.
